



In line with the Government publishing its *"Reframing the challenge - Continuing our recovery and reconnecting"* In order to review the current situation for the DF with respect to COVID-19 related matters a COVID-19 JOPG was held on the 15th of Sept.

The medical force protection of all personnel remains the priority of the General Staff.

The follow **decision** were provided by the General Staff:

1. DF Vehicles will return to 100% capacity with immediate effect - facemasks, cleaning and sanitation routines are still in place and where possible windows should be left partially open.
2. Organised indoor activities - limit of 100 people - Annex A gives full details where there is mixed immunity status'.
3. Restrictions on outdoor group activities are removed, spectators attendance to remain in line with regulations - Annex A for further details.
4. Antigen testing will continue during induction training.

The following **Updates and Guidance** were provided by the General Staff.

1. In line with national guidelines an increase in DF pers attending funerals to include a Bearer party of eight (8) in the church, The strength of the escort to line the route can revert to numbers permitted in line with Admin Instr A10.
2. 64th Inf Gp will commence isolation prior to their deployment to UNDOF on 23Sep.
