Operations

Ever thought how your equipment arrives into theatre? Logistics Branch DFHQ, better known as J4, have the sole responsibility for the deployment of Defence Forces assets overseas. The first step in the deployment planning process is to correctly quantify and classify the equipment. This then allows the DF to decide on whether the deployment will be conducted via: commercial, charter or by linking in with other militaries to gain lift capacity into mission areas.



The movement of weapons and ammunition can prove very difficult depending on both the classification of the goods and the final destination. Consideration must be given to not only the final destination but also any countries where our equipment tranships or overflights.

Did you know that your mobile phone battery classified as dangerous goods but your personal weapon is not.

These challenges were overcome during the most recent deployment to Mali which saw the J4 link with European partners to successfully deploy personnel along with their weapons and ammunition to the mission area.

Military & Government Collection


A database of full-text journals and periodicals pertaining to all branches of the military and government. It is designed to offer current news to military members, analysts, policy makers, students and researchers.

Public Hospital Medical Expenses

Admin Instruction A12 (New Series) Medical Treatment, Para 902.

Medical expenses incurred by Dependants of members of the Defence Forces.

"Members of the Defence Forces and their dependents will NOT be charged Public Inpatient or Out-Patient Service Charges provided they produce a properly completed AF715 to the hospital concerned" (AF715's are normally kept in Unit Orderly Rooms or they can also be found on IKON).

Also all members should make themselves aware of the PDFORRA Medical Assistance Scheme (PMAS). More info on this can be sought from your local PDFORRA representative.
